Justification	A range-restricted habitat specialist endemic to the Ceres Karoo and Roggeveld Mountains (extent of occurrence 1516 km <sup>2</sup> ), known from five subpopulations, this species has no recorded threats and is listed Rare nationally and Least Concern globally.
