Justification A range-restricted (EOO 819 km²) habitat specialist, but not threatened.

Endemism South African endemic
Provincial distribution Western Cape
Range Bitterfontein to the northern Knersvlakte.

Habitat and Ecology

Major system Terrestrial
Major habitats Succulent Karoo
Description Flats and gentle slopes covered with quartz gravel.

Population

This species is known from only a few records, but is minute (only about 10 mm tall when not in flower) and therefore easily overlooked. It is a habitat specialist of quartz fields, and therefore likely to be localized to suitable habitat, but collections note it to be locally common.
