 Justification A range-restricted species with an extent of occurrence (EOO) of 54 km<sup>2</sup> and an area of occupancy (AOO) of 24km<sup>2</sup>. Six threat based locations are declining as a result of illegal collecting for the specialist succulent horticultural trade.

### Threats

This range-restricted species has

recently subject to illegal collection, and there has been a recent significant increase in illegal collecting linked with a surge in demand for these plants facilitated by online platforms such as eBay.

## **Population**

This species is locally abundant in suitable habitat, with subpopulations consisting of more than 1000 individuals. The population is currently declining due to illegal collecting.
