Justification	Known from four sites in remote areas of Namaqualand. The only land use, goat herding, is not known to impact this species.

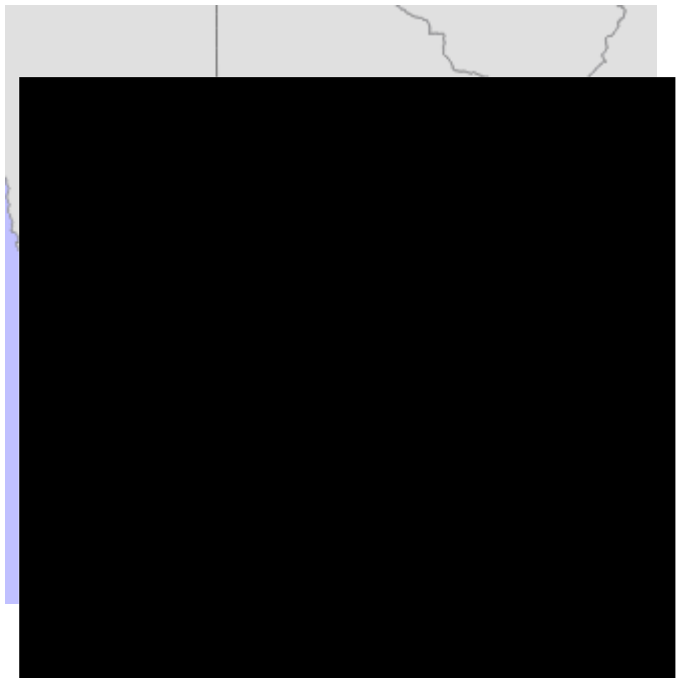

The area is predominantly used for livestock pasture, but grazing does not appear to negatively impact this species.
