Major habitats Fynbos

Description Rocky sites on granites in shrubby fynbos, above 1200 m.

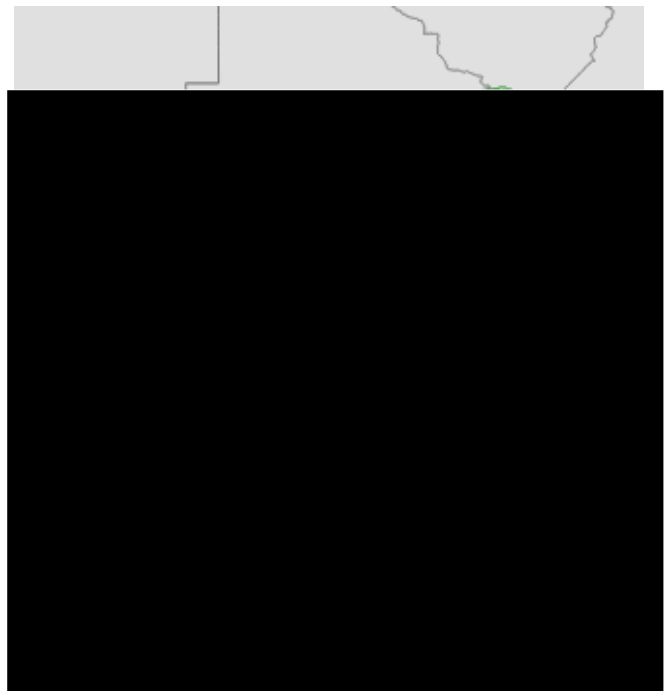
Threats
